2009 Summer Reading Program

- * Read for 30 minutes to get one spin of the spinner.
- * Keep track of reading on the Summer Reading Log.
- * Bring the log each week to the library to determine how many spins you may take at the game board.
- ** Read any books to participate in the program. We suggest using your Madison Public School list, Our Lady of Mercy or The Country School list as your reading guide. You will discover many wonderful titles.

*** * * Rules of the Game * * ***

Each 30 minutes of reading earns you one spin of the spinner.

Land on a red dot and back one space you go.

Land on a green dot and you move one space forward.

Land on a blue dot and answer a question. If you get the answer correct you move ahead one space. Incorrect answers you remain where you are on the board.

The 10 Turn rule - To keep any lines moving along, kids may spin the spinner up to 10 times. If they have read enough for more than ten spins, the player must go to the end of the line to play again if there are other players waiting.

Treasure Chest Prizes - Once a week, each player may select a prize from the treasure chest. You must have 8 checks to enter the treasure box.

When you finish the game.....

First time finishers receive a coupon for a ticket to a New Haven Raven's Baseball Game and a coupon for a free ice cream cone at Lenny & Joe's Fish Tale.

Second time finishers (and third, fourth, fifth, etc.) will be given a raffle ticket, which gives them a chance to win one of many special prizes.
