

CALLING ALL ARTISTS!



The Teen Advisory Board of the Scranton Memorial Library is holding a contest to design a mural to go in the space above the CD and DVD shelves in the teen section of the Library. The finished mural can be up to 24 feet long by 4 feet high.

Who can enter?

Anyone in grades 6-12 can enter. Just fill out an entry form with your contact information and a sketch of your design idea in the space provided.

How do I enter?

Pick up an entry form at the Teen Section of the library, or download a form at www.scrantonlibrary.org/teens.

Do I need to be an artist?

No, you just need to have an idea you would like to see big and on display. The winner of the contest is not obligated to help paint the final mural, but may help if they choose.

What should I draw?

You can draw anything; our only request is to keep it appropriate, as the final product will appear in a public space.

Does my design need to be in color?

The Teen Advisory Board would prefer a line drawing of your design without color, as the sketch will be scaled down so much.

Where do I submit my entry?

Forms need to be handed in at the Teen Desk, Scranton Library.

All entries are due by **August 14, 2009**. In the event that a suitable entry is not submitted, the Teen Advisory Board reserves the right to not choose a winner.
