

Annual Report 2019 - 2020

Dear Friends,

This has been an eventful year for the Scranton Library. In anticipation of moving back in to our renovated and expanded library building library staff spent time preparing new policies, training on new systems, and planning a full slate of exciting new programs, while also providing programs and services at our temporary location in North Madison.

Of course, as you know, nothing this year has gone according to plan. In response to the worsening pandemic we closed our doors on March 16th and took our services virtual, working our way up to an average of 9 programs per week on a variety of different platforms. Staff pivoted quickly and began offering assistance to our library users over the phone and online. In May we successfully packed up our operations at 1250 Durham Rd. and moved our library back downtown, all the while practicing social distancing and strictly adhering to health and safety protocols.

In July, just 3 days after receiving our Certificate of Occupancy, we debuted our contact-less "Take Out & Delivery" services to make our entire collection of library materials available to the public. Our partnership with the Madison Senior Center made free delivery of materials available to every Madison senior and we were so pleased to be able to safely get books and movies back into the hands of our library users.

While this year held unexpected challenges, it also had its share of triumphs. In January our Board of Trustees voted to approve an ambitious new three year strategic plan to usher in this new chapter in the library's history. We welcomed five new staff members in June and these talented individuals have quickly become integral to our success in these changing times. We also debuted a brand new website at a time when digital services have taken on new importance in all of our lives.

Amidst all of our disappointments and cancelled plans, there have been silver linings and lots of lemonade made from COVID-19 lemons. Thanks to the flexibility and resourcefulness of library staff I now know that whatever the next 12 months brings, we'll be able to find new and innovative ways to provide the high quality library services that bring people back to the Scranton Library year after year.

We look forward to seeing you soon and getting you connected to the books and resources that will meet your needs this coming year.



Year End Statistics

Visitors

In person - 165,665 Online - 735,398

Website traffic reached an all time high this year as our services went virtual during the COVID-19 pandemic. We saw a 30% increase in digital downloads during this time and a 100% increase in movie downloads through our Kanopy subscription.

Circulation

Physical items - 932,755 Digital items - 328,116

While circulation was temporarily suspended due to COVID-19 and our move back to the renovated library we quickly developed a contact-less "Take Out & Delivery" service and began safely getting library materials back in the hands of our patrons just 3 business days after passing our building inspection.

Our talented staff wasted no time moving library programs online following the Governor's Stay at Home order in March, 2020.
