November is a particularly good time to take stock of what this past year has held for us and take a moment to express gratitude for the good (and let go of the bad!). I find it very meaningful to take time to be thankful before the start of a busy holiday season and the hectic schedule that sometimes comes with it.

Here at the Library we're incredibly thankful that our daily operations have gotten back to nearly normal. Meeting rooms are now available and well over 500 people are making use of those spaces each month. Our study rooms are also in high demand, with well over 100 reservations each month. Programming continues to be popular and last year was a banner year for us. We held nearly 700 programs – an average of two programs PER DAY, with just under 35,000 participants of all ages!

The number of registered library card users also climbed 13% compared with the previous year and we are consistently breaking our own records for the number of new cards created monthly. We're so glad more and more people are signing up and using the Library all the time! We hope you'll join us at "Toast of the Town" to hear more about what you helped us accomplished last year and what we're looking forward to next. We couldn't do it without you and we want to say "thanks!"
